

## **Other Langemeijers in Netherlands - Sake Meindersma**

Almost all Langemeijers who now live in the Netherlands can be linked to the Langenhof. However, not all of them. In 2010 Fr. Langemeijer, b. in 1933, unmarried. He is a son of Hubert Langemeijer, b. In Moers(D) and Anna Maria Bechholz. The deceased has three married sisters. It is not known whether and how these Langemeijers are related to the Langemeijers of the Langenhof. Langemeijers are also mentioned in the past, of which this is not clear. At the beginning of the 19th century, Langemeijers are mentioned in Nederhorst ten Berg with clearly different first names.

## **Leeuwarder Langemeijers outside Leeuwarden**

### **The 4th generation.**

Of the 4th generation of Langemeijers of the Leeuwarden branch, no one lives in Leeuwarden anymore. Descendants in the 4th generation with the name Langemeijer, grandchildren, are only of Egidius Silverius, general practitioner in Amsterdam and Georg Felix merchant in Leeuwarden. Of Georg Felix there is only one grandson, son of Hermanus Hendericus Gerardus. This grandson Eduard Maria stayed in an asylum in Uden in the period 1920-1929. Before that, he was enrolled in Goirle in the period 1915-1916 as a technical student. After that, he lives until Nov. 1918 again in Leeuwarden. His profession was then director of the clothing workshop Fa. Joosten and Co. Nothing else is known about him

Grandchildren of Egidius Silverius are only from the sons Karel Herman and Eduard George. Eduard George, married to Wilhelmina de Crèvecoeur, had a son Gerard Eduard, born in Rheden on 3 October 1903 and died in Bloemendaal on 12 April 1990. Gerard Eduard would make a name for himself as a professor of law and attorney general. Gerard married Dr. Cornelia Maria van Schreven (1909-1984) in 1958. He has no children with her.

Karel Herman married 7 April 1885 in Maastricht with Maria Catharina Eugenia du Moulin, b. 9 Sept 1862 in Maastricht, died in The Hague on 17 June 1943. They had 4 children: Frans Silverius (5.1), b. in Zeist on 13 May 1886, Henri Gerard (5.2), b. 29 November 1887 in Zeist, Karel Louis (5.3), b. 7 April 1892 in Maastricht and Elisabeth Bertha Maria (5.4), born 6 August 1896 in Maastricht. On October 13, 1889, a lifeless daughter was born in Zeist.

In 1881, Karel and his partners founded a match factory, Vissers en Langemeijer en Co., in Stratum. This factory was taken over by a competitor in 1884. The marriage documents mention his profession as a beer brewer in 1885.

### **The 5th generation.**

5.1. Frans Silverius (\*13-05-1886, Zeist – †23-10-1954, Zwolle) married on 24 April 1917 in Hoorn with Antonia Maria Winkel, (\*15-11-1894, Hoorn – †30-11-1984, Zwolle). They had two children: Eugeni (6.1) and Henri (6.2). Frans Silverius had a career at Rijkswaterstaat. He started his career in Hoorn. He was then sent to the Antilles for two years. In 1920 he returned to the Netherlands. From about 1925 to 1929 he worked in the Dutch East Indies. He concludes his career as Chief Engineer-Director of the district of Overijssel and Drenthe from 1945 to 1952. The h.t.s. in Zwolle (then still m.t.s.) bore his name: the Ir. F.S. Langemeijerschool. As a tribute to his commitment to technical education in Zwolle.

5.2. Henri Gerard married Hendrika Melles (1887-) on 5 April 1910. They had 6 children: Karel Herman (1917-1917) Herman (6.3), K.H. (6.4), F. Henri (6.5), Maria Therese (6.6) and Dorathea Bernardina (6.7).

Henri Gerard is a general practitioner in Waalwijk and medical director of the Sint Nicolaas Hospital

Henri Gerard dies on 26 September 1963 in Waalwijk.

5.3. Karel Louis marries Sophie B.F.M.Goossens. They had 4 children: Julia (6.8), Karel (6.9), Henri Louis (6.10) and Fransiscus (6.11). Karel Louis was a judge at the District Court in Maastricht. He died on 25 November 1976 in Wassenaar.

5.4. Elisabeth Bertha Maria (Lisette) married Paul Marie Joseph Klinkenbergh (1892-) in 1922

### **The 6th generation.**

6.1. Eugenie François Antonia (Nini) (10-03-1919, Saint-Martin, Antilles.- 30 March 2014, Driebergen) married the surgeon Davy Vervat. Later medical director of the Sophia Children's Hospital in Rotterdam. After Vervat's retirement, they live in Vierhouten, Elspeterbosweg 148. They have one daughter, Hendrika Jacomine (Jacomine), b. August 17th, 1944. She dies young when she drives her car into a tree in an accident. The accident happened on September 29, 1983 on the Woudenbergseweg in Maarsbergen. Hendrika Jacomine was married to Hans Trost and had two children (Lou and Annette). The Trost family lives in Amersfoort in 1983. Nini lived in Apeldoorn in recent years, the last months in a nursing home in Driebergen.

6.2. Henri Cornelis Gerard (Hein, \*26-09-1922, Terneuzen- †10-04-2019, Zutphen) married Bernardina Manna de Jong (Bernice, \*27-02-1929, Almelo -†03-10-2009, Zutphen). They have two sons, Frank Pieter (7.1) (16-09-1955-) and Maarten Gerard (7.3) (03-07-1963 -) and a daughter Marjolein Louise (7.2). (26-04-1957 -) Lived from 1966 to 2004 in Losser, Hazenpad 5 and (after 1973) Grensweg 8. Hein studies between 1940 (during the war years he went into hiding with the De Wit family in Hardenberg) and 1951 in Delft as a mining engineer. After graduating, he worked for a short time in Bolivia, then for the Nederlandsche Aardolie Maatschappij (NAM) in Schoonebeek, where he lived in Emmen, Oldenzaal and De Lutte (gem. Losser). Later he worked for the British Petroleum Company (and then lived in The Hague and Pijnacker respectively) and for the Royal Dutch Salt Industry (KNZ/AKZO) in Hengelo. The family then lives in Losser. Hein and Bernice have lived in Zutphen since 2004

6.3. Herman E.H., b. on 8 April 1918 in Waalwijk and died there on 29 Nov. 1997, married M.T.A.M. Wehberg. They had four children: Noortje (7.4.), Ine (7.5.), Christianne (7.6.) and Charles Henri Maria (7.7). Herman was a general practitioner in Waalwijk.
